

Save the Date! The annual **Hunter's Lake Holiday Party** will be held **Sunday, December 15th** in the Hollyhock cul-de-sac beginning at 3 PM for all civic association paid members. There will be a \$5 per person fee for any non-resident guests of members. The 2024 (*if not yet paid*) and 2025 dues payments will be collected at the party. We accept checks, cash or Venmo. The annual dues are \$50 per household. You can also drop off your check to our treasurer, Krystin Lee, (3342 Foxridge) payable to "**Hunter's Lake Civic Association**". FYI—dues pay for neighborhood events, garage sale advertising, annual printed directories, the neighborhood spring BBQ, the annual holiday party in addition to the Xmas lights. Attached is a Directory Update Sheet to fill out.

Activities Available: Visit from Santa, a Bounce House (Parents - please supervise your children using the bounce house as we want everyone to have fun safely); face painting and a balloon guy, cornhole, Jenga, a bonfire for s'mores and a designated photo—op area.
